Social Studies

Students will continue their work on the same handout they've been using. They will do Task 7. For seniors, this task is expected to take two days (so it is labeled "Task 7 & 8"). The following are the instructions for students, taken directly from the handout.

Individuals & Societies (9th), World History (10th), and US History (11th):

Review your list of ten events. Determine which ONE of the ten events is the most important event or had the greatest impact on society. Again, there is no right or wrong answer. Develop a clear and concise claim that you support with reasoning and evidence from your prior learning in class. Present your argument in complete sentences and multi-paragraph format on a separate sheet of paper or word document.

*After completing your written response, underline your claim(s) and put a star next to each piece of evidence.

Government (12th Grade):

Again, reflecting on the handout "Principles and Virtues Glossary", create a visual representation, flow chart or mind map that demonstrates the relationships between the 15 principles in government and 15 virtues attributed to effective self-government.

 \cdot Your representation of how these 30 ideas are connected will be unique to you and there is no right or wrong way to demonstrate your thinking.

· Your representation may be messy and show lines connecting different ideas.

 \cdot You may choose to use colors, symbols and words to help make your connections more clear. Don't be afraid to think outside the box.

 \cdot You will continue to work on this during the following day.

· You may choose to create this representation by hand or use digital tools that you are familiar with.
