## Social Studies

All levels (9th through 12th) will complete the Question Formation Technique (QFT) visual analysis activity. There are four steps to the visual analysis that involves developing questions using a matrix that they've all seen in our social studies classes before. After they form their questions, they are to read the article in the document and answer the three questions that follow.

Instructions: Evaluate the image using the Question Formulation Technique (QFT) below. Follow the steps as you develop questions, categorize your questions, and then prioritize your questions. After you've prioritized your questions, read the article and answer the comprehension questions that follow.
