- 9th/10th Grade (Individuals & Societies; World History): Lesson 18- Students will complete the Megacity Case Study: Dar es Salaam. The instructions are embedded throughout the assignment.
- 11th Grade (US History): Students will complete the Lesson 18: Women in US Monuments assignment. They will read the article and answer the questions that follow.
- 12th Grade (US Government): Students will choose one activity from the Financial Literacy packet to complete. (They will do one per day until Distance Learning is over).
