All seniors must bring their Student ID to pick up their diploma.

You are the only person allowed to leave your vehicle – all others you bring with you must remain in the car and keep the car moving to the next station to pick you up after the photo.

You may not drive with another senior to this event, and you will be turned away if you do (unless that senior is a sibling and also graduating).

You must have someone drive you, as you cannot leave your car unattended and we need to keep cars moving through each station we've set up.

Again, as a reminder during the photo opportunity, all seniors must maintain a 6' social distancing at all times. No hugging, hand shaking, high-fiving, etc. Seriously, we understand that you miss each other and we miss you as well, but you cannot do this.
