## Cadets will not need uniforms for awards night. It is a webinar, so only presenters will have video and audio.

<u>Uniform Turn-In</u> during the week of 1-5 June you will turn in your uniforms when you go to campus on the day you've been assigned. Watch last Giddy Up at <u>link</u> below. Here are more details:

- Seniors and all not returning to Wooster JROTC
- o Items I need back: **CORDS**, garment bag, grey shirt, class A coat, pants, windbreaker jacket, tie/neck tab, shoes, belt and buckle, and beret. (I do not want white t-shirts and socks back)
- o Remove everything from Class A coat and grey shirt (name tags, rank, ribbons, torches, etc.)
- o You may keep the ribbons, name tags, rank, etc. or turn it in
- o Tie shoes together by the laces
- o Show up on turn in day with everything separated
- Anyone returning to Wooster JROTC next School year
- o Items I need back: **CORDS**, garment bag, grey shirt, class A coat, pants, windbreaker jacket, tie/neck tab, shoes, belt and buckle, and beret.
- o Remove everything from Class A coat and grey shirt (name tags, rank, ribbons, torches, etc.)
- o Pants, class A coat, grey shirt and windbreaker need to be separate from garment bag to turn in as separate items
- The following items will stay in your garment bag: berets, shoes, ribbons, name tags, rank, ties, belts with buckles, t-shirts and socks. Bags will get stored in range for the summer.

#### <u>AP Students:</u> (Mondays for rest of SY)

Please review the following information about your AP exams:

- Details about e-tickets for the exams:
  - Students can't take this year's AP exam without their e-ticket
  - College Board will send the e-tickets by email 2 days before the exam (they can also be found in your My AP account)
  - Students need it to check in to their exams on exam day (you should check in 30 minutes before the start of your exam)

- Each test will have a unique e-ticket
- Each e-ticket is personalized to each student and contains your AP ID so DO NOT share it.
- If students experience a problem during the test, you need to fill out this form ASAP: <u>https://education.co1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV\_1B9R7XJa9dXaQBv</u>
  - Only fill this out if you attempted the test and were not able to complete your exam.
  - If you received your e-ticket for the test in May, but did not use the e-ticket, you DO NOT need to submit this form. You will automatically receive another e-ticket for the June test.
  - It CANNOT be used for the portfolio courses (at Wooster, those are AP Computer Science Principles and our Art and Design classes).

- Remember, you can take the test in three ways:
  - 1. Use pen and paper to write your exam and then upload pictures
  - 2. Type your answers in a word document or similar software and upload the file
  - 3. Type your answers and "cut and paste" your answer into the test software
- If you have trouble logging into your My AP account, we are unable to help you unlock your account.
  - 4. You MUST call AP yourself as it is your account, not Wooster's account
  - 5. If you are locked out, please call AP's students and parents line
