Uniform Turn-In during the week of 1-5 June you will turn in your uniforms when you go to campus on the day you've been assigned. Watch last Giddy Up at [link](#) below. Here are more details:

- Seniors and all *not returning to Wooster JROTC*
 - Items I need back: **CORDS**, garment bag, grey shirt, class A coat, pants, windbreaker jacket, tie/neck tab, shoes, belt and buckle, and beret. (I do not want white t-shirts and socks back)
 - Remove everything from Class A coat and grey shirt (name tags, rank, ribbons, torches, etc.)
 - You may keep the ribbons, name tags, rank, etc. or turn it in
 - Tie shoes together by the laces
 - Show up on turn in day with **everything** separated
- *Anyone returning to Wooster JROTC next School year*
 - Items I need back: **CORDS**, garment bag, grey shirt, class A coat, pants, windbreaker jacket, tie/neck tab, shoes, belt and buckle, and beret.
 - Remove everything from Class A coat and grey shirt (name tags, rank, ribbons, torches, etc.)
 - Pants, class A coat, grey shirt and windbreaker need to be separate from garment bag to turn in as separate items
 - **The following items will stay in your garment bag:** berets, shoes, ribbons, name tags, rank, ties, belts with buckles, t-shirts and socks. Bags will get stored in range for the summer.

Students are on lesson #21 (if students are utilizing the electronic forms only, they just need to click on the assignment listed under lesson #21 for their current class in the Mathematics Distance Learning file that everyone should have posted on Teams, but if they are working from the paper packet I have also included the page numbers that correspond with the daily assignment). The assignments are as follows:

Algebra 1 - Lesson 21 (paper packet page 28)

Geometry - Lesson 21 (paper packet page 41-42)

Algebra 2 - Lesson 21 (paper packet page 56)

Pre-Calc - Lesson 21 (online access only)

Prob/Stats - Lesson 21 (online access only)

Pre-College - Lesson 21 (online access only)

Remember for the 4th years subjects that only have online assignments that students who are working in paper packets can do the Algebra 2 assignment as a replacement assignment.
