## WOOSTER ATHLETICS 2020-2021

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Winter season “will” start on January 2, 2021. Followed by fall, then spring sports. Each season will be 6 weeks long. You might have heard our announcements mention the importance of getting athletes registered for sports now due to the shortened seasons. It is imperative to complete register my athlete (RMA). If students/parents wait until the last minute, it will not be a case of the athlete “might” miss their season, THEY WILL MISS IT.

1. Students & Parents need to understand that the shortened seasons makes it critical that they register now. We don't want athletes missing their seasons (or any portion of them). Many students may still not be physically in school and perhaps unsure the season will even start, however you need to plan for the season to start on time.
2. Some students/parents may be nervous about paying fees. We recommend you complete all portions of the registration process. Fees can be collected later. Certain fees such as \$50.00 transportation & \$5.00 Impact fees are standard across WCSD and are required, and are out of Wooster High Schools control. We will let you know.
3. All athletes need a current physical. if you wait until two weeks before the season starts to schedule a physical you will probably miss part or all of your season. There will be no try outs or practice without a current physical and completed RMA.
4. All three seasons are open for registration at this time. Completion of the registration process will register you for multiple sports.
5. All athletes will be required to have a 2.00 at term one of 2020. Per the NIAA.

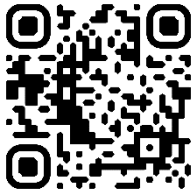

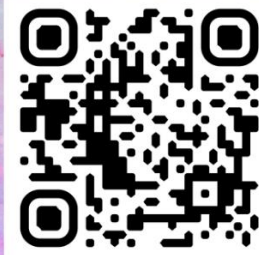
