



## IB SHADOWING AT WOOSTER



Are you interested in finding out more about Wooster's IB Diploma Program or the IB Career Program?

One of the best ways to really get a feel for our school, the IB program, the students and the teachers, is for your student to shadow one of our IB Ambassadors. We offer full or ½ day shadowing appointments

### Shadow Dates, Question and Answer Sessions and tours for parents.

- 1 Shadowing, and Q & A Sessions and tours for parents will happen most days, from October – January.
- 2 Shadow day schedule: We offer ½ day shadowing from 7:45 a.m. – 12:20 p.m., or full day 7:45 a.m. – 2:30 p.m.
  - **7:45 a.m.** - Drop off your child at Wooster's main office (Use Harvard Way entrance. At main office you will see a flag pole and a giant white rock with the Wooster sign in front).
    - 7:55 Ambassadors will pick up your student and take them to their 1<sup>st</sup> class. Your child will follow this student around until lunch time.
  - **12:20 – lunch time.** Your child will be brought to the career center/library where they will eat lunch with the other shadows and ambassadors. They will be able to ask questions and meet coaches and other teachers at this time. Students will also reflect on their experiences throughout the day and provide feedback.
    - **Please have your child bring a sack lunch.**
  - **For students continuing on for the full day, 12:55** – students will attend the last class of the day. At 2:30, your child will be brought back to the main office, and this is where you will need to pick them up.
  - **Answers to commonly asked questions:** Students do not need to wear their school uniforms, but please follow the WCSD dress code. Yes, you can ask to shadow a specific student as long as the student is an IB Ambassador and is not a sibling.

### Parent/guardian Tours:

On the morning that you drop off your child for a shadowing appointment, parents can sign up for a 30-minute question and answer session, and a tour of our campus. The tour will be given by IB Ambassadors, and the question-and-answer session will be held with the IB Diploma Coordinator. Parents can also sign up for the Q & A session and tour even if their child is not shadowing that day. Alternatively, we understand that many parents need to run to work, and it is perfectly fine with us if you just want to sign your child in at the front office, and then go to work.

Students can choose to shadow on a 1-2-3 day (Eng-Hist-World Language/Math), or a 4-5-6 day (Math/World Language-Elective-Science) depending on their curricular interests. They will be paired with an Ambassador of similar interests.
